2020 Ministry Opportunities



Early in the year the Lord exposed us to the privilege of partnering with a ministry that has been serving with us in Jamaica. They teach the word of God to marginalized students as well as computer skills to get them ready for the job market. They expressed their desire and need for computers for the ministry. We presented this opportunity to our church, Calvary Chapel, and we were blessed with 14 iMac complete computers. We were blessed with the privilege of sending these computers to Operation Save Jamaica only a few weeks before the pandemic.

Sometime in last year we were blessed to serve alongside a church in Costa Rica by sending 1,500 of our Face to Face booklets in Spanish along with bibles. The ministry went extremely well. Early in 2020 we got another request for more booklets and bibles. Along with our church, Calvary Chapel, and our faithful partners

we were able to ship over 3,000 booklets to Costa Rica. God blessed in an amazing way and they were able to start a little church in a remote area as a result of the fruit of the outreach. God is faithful!



Jamaica

For the first time in 27 years this ministry was not able to send care bags and supplies to the Jamaica Child Evangelism fellowship as we have done in the past to minister to the Good News Club students as a result of the pandemic. We thank God that through the giving of some of our faithful friends in the ministry we were able to send \$1,200 USD to our missionary who is still able to minister to some of the students.

Dominica

We were blessed at the start of the school year in September to be given the opportunity to minister in the Island of Dominica. There was a hunger for good literature for the High school students. Again the Lord blessed us with the privilege of sending 3,000 copies of the ministry's Face to Face and No Worries booklets directly to the Portsmouth High School in Dominica from where booklets were distributed to other schools. The ministry is supervised by a Christian Principal on the Island of Dominica.

Panama

In the month of August one of our board members Angel Baloa introduced the ministry to a pastor from Panama and who was seeking to do ministry to students and could desperately use the booklets from the ministry to reach students in Panama. God in His faithfulness previously allowed us to have had all the booklets translated in Spanish. When the opportunity came God provided through the consistent online donation of a few as well as through those who heard of the opportunity and jumped right in and gave. As a result we were able to ship 16,000 booklets to Panama including leaders guide. The ministry is currently moving on with 14 evangelical churches working together to reach out to students and their families with the Gospel.

As the Word of God tells us all, we do not rejoice in all the wonderful things being done but rather in the fact that our names are written in heaven. Thank you all for serving with us. Jesus is coming quickly and very soon we will all rejoice together when we meet those He brought to the Kingdom!
