St. Lucia Report: January 2018 —July 6th, 2018

We greet you in the Wonderful Name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

1,564 Face to Face booklets were presented to four Secondary Schools and one Juvenile Institution, between two school terms: January/March and April/July. The schools included Castries Comprehensive, Vide-Boutielle, Entrepot and George Charles secondary school. The book distribution and gospel presentation to the students did not occur as we would have preferred. We were hindered at some of the schools and could not do any mass presentation.

This interruption came as a direct result of the arrival of 'questionable' books sent to all the elementary schools, from One World Schoolhouse Foundation of Canada - the Rainforest reading program. The books sparked lots of controversies because amongst the ten books sent to the schools, two had about boys who loved wearing dresses and a purse. Along with another two about talking to imaginary monsters. In response to this, the Ministry of Education issued a caution that any book to be received from overseas for St. Lucian students, must first be perused by the principal/Counselors. To summarize the impact: presentations did not go on smoothly and some schools have not responded to our request for distribution/presentation.



Special points of interest:

- Pray concerning the situation highlighted in the report.
- Pray for Ms. Josephine Albert, who is a new addition to the Lifeline Gospel Family in St. Lucia.
- Pray for school officials to welcome the gospel in their schools.
- Pray for Lifeline Gospel ministry workers/partners.
- Pray that God will provide a person (Believer) that will work along side me to labor for Him at the various schools.
- At least 500 No Worries booklets are needed for the new school term.

Upton Gardens Girls Centre

The Centre caters for St. Lucia's juvenile delinquent girls. Twelve teenagers from the Centre received the Face to Face booklets, along with the Director and 2 Counselors receiving the Leader's guide. The leader's guide will be used on a continuous basis to facilitate group sessions. The girls responded to the truth of God's word very well. However, much prayers are need for renewal of hearts and minds. A photo can be seen with Ms. Josephine and some of the girls.

In addition, I would like to expand on the last report we sent you on the German Team to Jamaica.:

The ministry in Jamaica with our team from Germany was a tremendous success. Following is a breakdown of their ministry in several schools in Kingston and Portmore:

Greater Portmore High School: 110 cards (52 checked the sinner's prayer box)

Cumberland High School (Portmore): 143 cards (36 checked the sinner's prayer box)

Kingston Technical High School: 140 cards (93 checked the sinner's prayer box)

We visited three more schools but didn't pass out decision cards because either the kids were too young or the setting wasn't appropriate.

You will see that not all of the kids checked the box confirming they invited Jesus to be their Savior. Many of them did, though, and we pray for those that did not. May God convict their hearts soon so that the seeds will grow.
